I absolutely loved Albertha. She was an incredible woman. We all only wanted her to take our blood.



I have many beautiful memories of her but four great ones that I would like to share.

My father would only let her draw his blood. She was always so kind and loving to him. When my dad would go, if she was not working, he would leave and come back. He went to her for years and years in good and bad health. One of his last outings when he knew he only had a couple of weeks left of life, he had me take him to her lab to say goodbye. She gave him the biggest hug that I think he every got. It put such a smile on his face that day.

Albertha volunteered for one of the largest attended Bone Marrow Drives at the old Wando. People lined up for hours and hours. In fact, they had to extend the drive for a second day where she returned again and volunteered. I can't even imagine how many hours that she was on her feet for those two days. She took my sample for the Bone Marrow Registry and three years later I ended up being a perfect match for a mother in St Louis, Missouri. The bone marrow transplant was a success and my recipient just celebrated her 20 year anniversary this past July.

One hot summer day, our son, Nicholas had to have blood drawn. I think he was maybe three or four. My dad and mom tried to tell her that it was going to take three people to hold him down. She said she wasn't going to deal with that so we left him in the room with just her and my dad. They were out in five minutes.

Years later I asked her how she did that and she laughed and said that she told him if he was not still she would call his Daddy and Scott and tell him them he could never go to the College of

Charleston baseball field again!

Many times when I was going through cancer, she always gave me the best advice. Sometimes I actually looked forward to having my blood drawn just so I could spend time listening to her talk about her family and all that was going on.
