Mr. Issaac S. Green, 73, of North Charleston, SC, entered eternal rest on Friday, September 5, 2025

Issaac Samuel Green was born on October 21, 1951, to Harris Samuel Green and Earline Parker Green. Affectionately known as Samuel or Sam, he left his earthly home on Friday, September 5, 2025, to enter his heavenly home and reside eternally with our Lord and Savior, Jesus the Christ.

Samuel attended the public schools of Charleston, SC. His education began at Buist Elementary School, and he graduated from C.A. Brown High School. He went on to attend the College of Charleston and later enrolled at Neilson Electronics in Charleston. From an early age, Samuel showed both a passion for and an uncanny ability in electrical wiring. Using these skills, he transformed his mother's living room into a "disco" ballroom with a "disco" ball and all. He also worked as the sound man for several local bands in the Charleston area. His other interests included carpentry, tile work, and house painting. Sam recently worked as Sexton at Zion Olivet Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and as Maintenance Technician at BOWs (Beyond Our Walls-nonprofit organization).

In 1971, Sam enlisted in the United States Army.

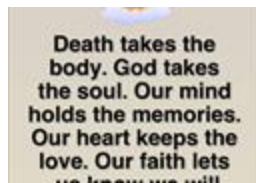
