Mrs. Viola Robinson, 91, of Charleston, SC entered into eternal rest on January 1, 2023. Ms. Viola, affectionately known as “Vi”, was born October 24, 1931, in Charleston, S.C. to the late Mrs. Jessie Mae Evans. Viola attended public schools in Charleston and as a young woman, she moved to Harlem, New York in the early 1950s for work. She was employed in service until she retained a position at Lincoln Hospital, Bronx, NY. Vi returned to Charleston in the late 1970s and worked in retail until 1999.
